CITY OF BELLBROOK, OHIO **ORDINANCE NO. 2008-1**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND A MOTION OF COUNCIL AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION AND PUBLICATION OF NEW MATTER IN THE UPDATED AND REVISED CODIFIED ORDINANCES; AND REPEALING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the American Legal Publishing Corporation has completed its most recent updating and revision of the Codified Ordinances of the City; and

WHEREAS, various ordinances and a motion of Council of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council since the date of the last updating and revision of the Codified Ordinances (February 23, 2004) and have been included in the Codified Ordinances of the City; and

WHEREAS, certain changes were made in the Codified Ordinances to bring City law into conformity with State law.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLBROOK HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 3. That the following sections are hereby repealed.

636.14 Party Lines to be yielded in emergencies.
642.205 Identity Theft

Section 4. That all ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of the new matter adopted in Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance except as follows:

- a) The enactment of such sections shall not be construed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of such enactment, or an action or proceeding for the enforcement of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision, nor to affect an indictment or prosecution therefore. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for the purpose of revision and recodification.
- b) The repeal provided above shall not affect any legislation enacted subsequent to December 10, 2007.

Section 5. Pursuant to Section 5.04 of the Municipal Charter, Section 222.01 of the Codified Ordinances and Ohio R.C. 731.23, the Clerk of Council shall post a copy of this ordinance, together with a summary of the new matter approved, adopted and enacted by Section 2 of this ordinance, which Summary is attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A, in the five public places set forth in Section 222.01 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law, and copies of the 2007 Replacement Pages hereby approved, adopted and enacted shall be distributed as provided in Section 5.10(c) of the Municipal Charter.
