**ORDINANCE NO. 2008-11**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PREVIOUS PERSONNEL ORDINANCES TO MAKE CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS IN THE CITY OF BELLBROOK PERSONNEL ORDINANCE AND SALARY SCALE.**

WHEREAS, the City has met with its non-exempt full-time police employees and agreed upon the terms of an extension of the existing labor agreement on salaries, benefits and work rules; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to incorporate the wage provisions into the general personnel policies of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLBROOK HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Bellbrook City Council hereby approves the City Manager's execution of a one-year extension of the existing agreement between the City and the non-exempt full-time Police Department employees (members of The Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc.) with effective dates of August 1, 2008 to July 31, 2010. Cost of living adjustments in the additional year will be 3.0 percent on August 1, 2009. These increases shall also apply to all other non-elected City employees with the exception of the Clerk of Council and the City Manager.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
