ORDINANCE NO. 2009-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2008-17 TO ADJUST THE CITY OF BELLBROOK APPROPRIATIONS TO REFLECT ADDITIONAL COSTS IN SOME LINE ITEMS AND REDUCED COSTS IN OTHERS.
