### RESOLUTION NO. 2009-E

#### **A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION. (Rev. Code, Sec. 5705.19, .191, .192, .194 .21, .26)**

The City of Bellbrook, Greene County, Ohio, met in Regular Session on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February 2009, in Bellbrook City Council Chambers with the following members present:

Robert Baird, Council Member

Joe Ritzel, Council Member

Mr. Ritzel moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said City of Bellbrook, Greene County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLBROOK HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That with two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the City of Bellbrook for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus and buildings, or the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighters to operate the same, including the payment of the firefighter employers' contribution required under section 742.34 of the Revised Code, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department at a rate not exceeding 2.0 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to twenty cents (\$ .20) for each one hundred dollars of valuation for an additional tax of 2.0 mills for a continuing period of time for tax year 2009 first collected in 2010.

Section 2. That the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said City of Bellbrook at the primary election to be held at the usual voting places within said City of Bellbrook on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 2009.

Section 3. That said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Section 4. That the Clerk of this City of Bellbrook be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Greene County, Ohio, immediately after its passage and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
