RESOLUTION NO. 2009-Q

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND THE BELLBROOK POLICE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR FUNDING, AND IF AWARDED, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO ADMINISTER A D.A.R.E. GRANT THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Bellbrook Police Department instructs the D.A.R.E. curriculum in the Sugarcreek School system; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Attorney General's office supplies limited grant funding to support D.A.R.E. instruction throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds available would aid the Bellbrook Police Department and the citizens of Bellbrook in providing the D.A.R.E. curriculum to students during the 2009-2010 school year.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLBROOK HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager and the Bellbrook Police Department are hereby authorized to apply for funding for the D.A.R.E. program for the 2009-2010 school year, from the State of Ohio Attorney Generals' Office.

Section 2. That, if the funding is awarded, the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Attorney General's Office to administer a D.A.R.E. grant.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force forthwith.
