May 28, 2023 – 1240 hours

A Peace Officer standby was requested on W. Franklin St. for a child custody exchange.

May 28, 2023 – 1951 hours

Officers were dispatched to Kensington Drive on a barking dog complaint. Officers located the owner, who promptly brought the dogs inside.

May 28, 2023 – 2216 hours

While on patrol, officers located a suspicious vehicle at Magee Park. Officers contacted the occupants and informed them of the park being closed. No criminal activity was suspected and they left the area without incident.

May 29, 2023 – 0338 hours

Officers were alerted to a possible protection order violation on W. Franklin Street. After confirming the identity of the subjects and the active protection order, one person was placed under arrest for TPO Violation and transported to the Greene County Jail.

Officers responded to a business on W. Franklin Street on the report of an unwanted subject that had been at the business the day before asking for money and openly drinking alcoholic beverages. Officers located the known subject and trespassed them from the business.

Officers located a subject on S. Main Street known to have active warrants out of Montgomery County. After a short foot chase, officers were able to arrest the subject and transport him to Greene County Jail. In addition to the warrants, he was also charged with Resisting Arrest and Obstructing Official Business.



May 29, 2023 – 2357 hours

Officers were dispatched to a business on State Route 725 on the report of a subject passed out in a running vehicle. Officers were able to awaken the individual and detected a strong odor of alcohol. The subject was cited for OVI – Physical Control and released to a responsible party.

Officers assisted with a vehicle lockout on Sable Ridge Drive. Entry gained.
